

## The Media of Mediumship: Esotericism Studies Beyond the Academy

In this talk, I introduce and reflect on The Media of Mediumship, a recent AHRC-funded public engagement and impact project held in collaboration with the Science Museum Group and Senate House Library which aimed to publicize and create new perspectives scientific collection materials related to the histories of modern spiritualism, psychical research, and occultism. Scientific archives such as SMG have an immense potential value for esotericism studies researchers, overly-prescriptive that an one attachment to the rejection hypothesis might prevent us from identifying. Here I discuss what the project taught us about how to work productively with stakeholders holding differing, sometimes directly opposed, positions on the role of occultism within the history of science and science curation. Finally, the talk considers how going public with the material culture of socalled rejected knowledge might help esotericism studies scholars to rethink some of the central paradigms in their field.
