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Sociology offers a spectrum of qualitatively oriented approaches, each providing specific methods of data collection and analysis that can be appropriately applied to field research in religious studies. We will discuss its methodological background and the practical steps involved in designing and using one, and we will come to understand the general advantages and limitations of this method.
